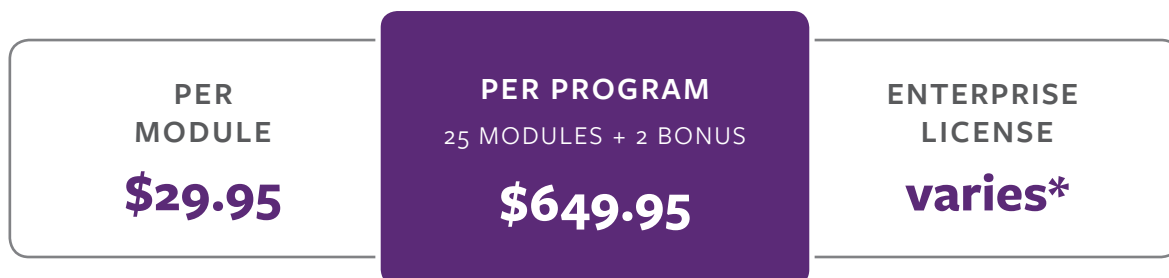

Preceptor Training Program Pricing

The Preceptor Training Program is designed and structured to be taken sequentially in its entirety, at the learner's own pace. It consists of 25 online modules (on average, 50 minutes each) with each awarding continuing education credit (CE/CME). Participants must successfully complete a brief evaluation prior to receiving a certificate of completion. Modules are also available individually.

The Preceptor Training Program is an approved provider for continuing education through the California Board of Registered Nursing (CA BRN) and a partnership with the American Association of Physician Assistants (AAPA). Accreditation through the Accreditation Board for Specialty Nursing Certification (ABSNC) is currently being pursued for nursing-related modules as well as Joint Accreditation so all clinical roles may receive the appropriate CE/CME credit.

The Advanced Practice Provider (APRN & PA) series will be available in early 2024. Other series--nursing (RN), pharmacy (PharmD), medicine (MD/DO), physical therapy & occupational therapy (PT/OT), administrators, and academics--will be available subsequently in 2024.



Purchases include unlimited access for one (1) year.
